Submissions

EuroPLoP accepts papers containing patterns or pattern languages as well as experience reports and papers related to the theory and use of patterns.

Proceedings will be published in the ACM Digital Library (approval pending).

Submissions should fall into one of the following categories:

- Pattern papers containing one or more patterns
- Papers on applying patterns in practice
- Focus group proposals (focus groups are free-format discussion groups or workshops)

First-time pattern authors are welcome to contact the conference chairs (see below) to receive an introductory information pack.
